












Little Charmers: Baby Christmas

The colors listed here are only suggestions - feel free to use the colors that you prefer. We used red for the word, "1st" and "blue for "2nd" only to make them easier to work with - use whatever colors fit with your project.












All of these designs have been sewn out several times on different machines using two layers of tear away stabilizer.












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Please note: some machines may report "Applique" or "Applique Position" for one of the colors. This is usually for areas that are a skin tone. We use Isacord #1060 which is a very pale peach for these sections. Just substitute the skin tone color of your preference. **There are no applique parts in these designs.**

You may note that some of our designs have two or more stops for the color black. This is because the elements, like facial features, are tiny and very close together. Rather than leaving tiny jump stitches that are hard to remove, your machine will stop, tie off stitches and move to the beginning of the next element. You can just start it up again (without changing thread colors). This will make your sewout neater and will mean less trimming when you are finished.

The text in these designs are always the last two color stops. If you want to use this on a different design or by itself, you can skip elements 1 through 9 and start sewing with #10. On the other hand, if you want the design without the text, sewout 1 through 9 and stop.

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
