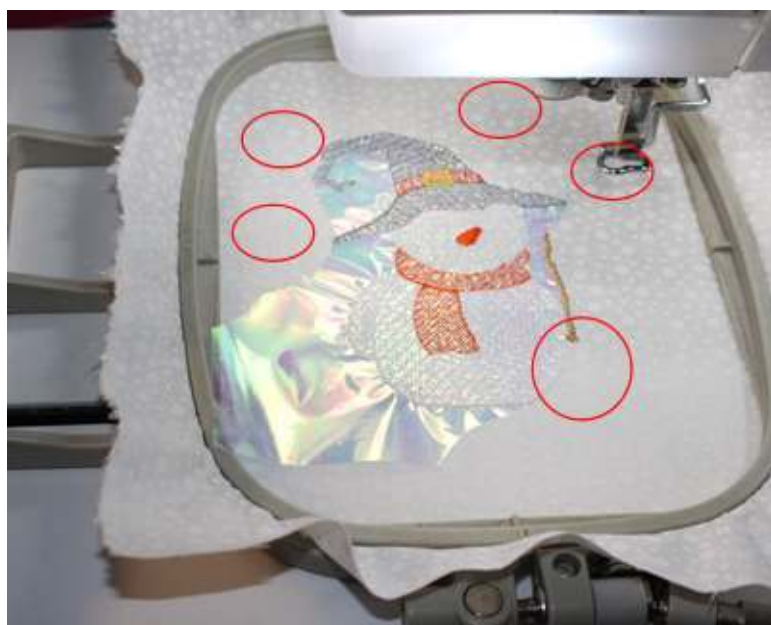


Special Embroidery Tip For Mylar Snowmen

If you have been using our Mylar Snowmen, you will have noticed that almost all have little snowflakes across the top. These are not “optimized for mylar” so you have to pick the mylar out from behind them.

There is a simple tip that I use each time I sew them out: when you get to the light blue color stop for the snowflakes, pause and remove the mylar from the area where those snowflakes will go.



For Free Mylar Snowman #139 there is a second area that makes picking out the mylar a little annoying.

Note the way the broom is made. There are lines for the twigs that make the bottom of the broom.

If you remove the mylar from that area before sewing out the final black outline, you will not have to pick out mylar from that area at the end!

The red circles on the photo above are approximately where these non-mylar objects would sew out.

As you can see, I pulled the excess mylar off from those areas before sewing the last two color stops.

That made the “clean up” after the design was finished really quick and easy.
